Will my child have side effects from the vaccine?

The side effects that kids experience are mild, and they are ones we saw for other age groups, like teenagers and young adults. These side effects are normal signs that the body is building protection.

Most Common Side Effects

On the arm where child received the shot:

- Soreness
- Pain
- Swelling

Throughout the rest of the body:

- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills
- Fever

Helpful Tips

If you have pain or fever after getting vaccinated, talk to your doctor about taking an over-the-counter medicine.

To reduce pain and discomfort where you got the vaccine:

- Apply a cool washcloth over the area
- Use or gently exercise your arm

To reduce discomfort from fever:

- Stay hydrated
- Rest up
