Dear Parents/Guardians of Excel Prom Participants,

The 2022 Excel Academy Charter High School Prom is almost here! The Senior Prom this year will take place at the Hyatt Regency in Boston on Friday, June 3rd from 7:00-11:00pm. Tickets for Prom are \$45 which includes the cost of dinner. The Prom Committee is working hard to provide an elegant and enjoyable evening. It is our hope to see every Senior at this special event. In this letter, I would like to provide some logistical information about the Prom is listed below:

- All students and guests will be subject to being searched upon entering prom. Students and guests will be searched for prohibited and illegal substances (drugs, alcohol, weapons).
- If a student consumes/uses drugs or alcohol before or during prom, parents will be notified.
- Any Senior or guest found in possession of or under the influence or demonstrating inappropriate behavior will forfeit their evening during prom, with no refunds. Depending on behavior, Excel student may be suspended from school and/or may not participate in the Graduation ceremony.
- Excel student will be held responsible for the behavior of guest. Therefore, if a guest of student misbehaves, both the student and guest will be asked to leave the premises.
- A Prom Guest Approval Form must be submitted and pre-approved for any guest who is not an Excel student. Guests will be required to show photo identification at prom.
- Guests who are Excel students in the 11th grade will have weekly behavior check ins
 with their grade level Dean to determine if they can attend prom. A permission slip will
 also need to be signed by the parent/guardian of 11th grade students.
- No one will be admitted entry after 8pm.
- Anyone who leaves prom prior to its ending will be denied re-entry.
- All persons are responsible for their own transportation to and from prom.
- All students must be picked up or have a mode of transportation at the end of the event at 11pm.

It is a privilege for students to be attending this event and can be revoked by Administration at any time. If a student becomes ineligible due to behavior issues, this privilege will be revoked. A student violating these rules may have his/her parents called and will be asked to leave the prom. No refunds will be issued in the event that a student is asked to leave prom. There will be disciplinary consequences for any violation of the Student Code of Conduct. "Before/After Prom" activities are in no way affiliated or sponsored by Excel Charter High School.
